Inktober Monthly Drawing Rubric

Requirement	Description	Value	Received
Design	The design is clearly representing <u>ONE</u> of the drawing prompts provided. The design is well thought out, shows detail, and is a large-scale drawing. The design is 100% original (not copied in any way). The student's FULL name is written in the lower right corner, along with #inktober2022, and the chosen drawing prompt	30	
Craftsmanship	The overall artwork shows effort and creativity. All pencil marks are covered up with a marker or pen, showing contrast between dark and light areas to make it more appealing. All eraser marks are covered (not visible), and the composition overall looks complete & well thought out.	20	
Composition	The overall composition is cohesive and tells a story and/or is able to read which drawing prompt is being illustrated. The composition size takes up at least 50% of the paper (large-scale drawing) and shows appropriate details. The entire drawing is completed in some form of ink; showing contrast between darks and lights.	30	
Documentation	At the bottom right corner of the Inktober drawing prompt has the student's full name, #INKTOBER2022, & which drawing prompt is being illustrated. The artwork is photographed where nothing but the artwork is shown (camera hovering over the paper and the artwork fills the frame of the camera). This photograph is uploaded to the student's individual portfolio and turned in on time. IN THE PORTFOLIO: Slide title: #INKTOBER2022, The chosen prompt, image of the artwork, & a brief description of the artwork (what it is, what you used for inspiration, if any, what materials you used)	20
