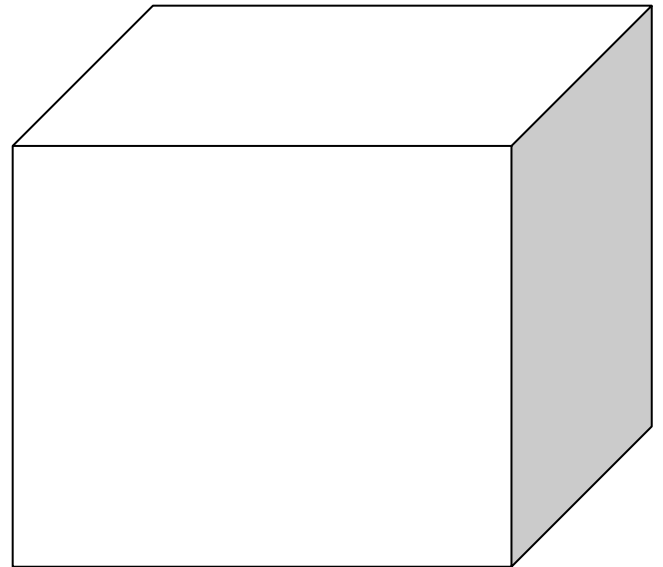
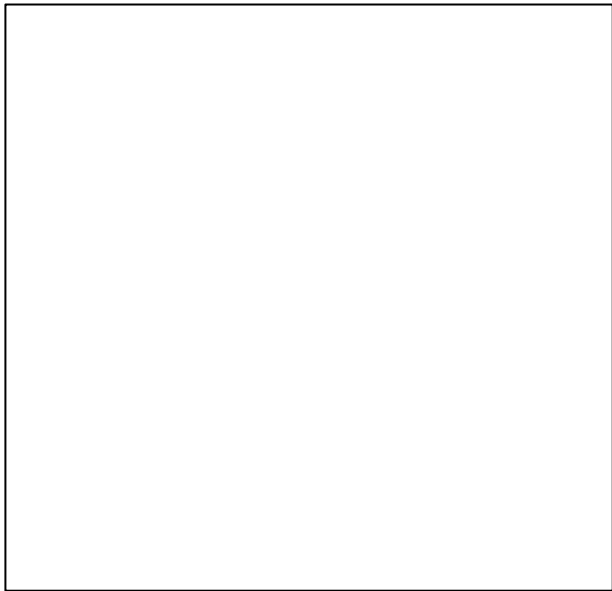
- After learning about lines, shapes, and forms, you will be introduced to new tools in Adobe Illustrator
- Watch the demonstration AND use the tutorial to help you remember what tools need to be used / requirements for the project

Part 2 Cont'd

- You are going to make 4 different shapes in AI (Adobe Illustrator)
 - 2 shapes can be made by using the shape tool
 - 2 shapes can be made by using the pen tool

Using multiple artboards, you are going to show the original shape and it changing to a form

- Once you have your 4 shapes turning into forms, save your AI document to your drive
