● LEARN ABOUT PLAYING CARDS

- Use our website for information, resources, and inspiration if you missed Mrs. Mendola's spiel or if you just want to check it out on your own at your leisure.
 - Its valuable information!

PICKING A CARD TO DESIGN

- There will be a few steps in picking a card to design and how to begin the design process
- Be sure to follow along each day and if you get lost or miss something use the tutorial on the website to help you!

STEP 1:

- **To choose a playing card at random, you are going to pick a card, ANY card**
 - **NO PEEKING!**
- **If you are not a 'fan' of the card you drew, you are allowed one 're-draw'**
 - **You are not allowed to choose the original card drawn if you do not like the re-draw card**

OR

you can steal someone's card one time

- **PAY ATTENTION to who has what card and what you want to design because you are NOT allowed to ask what they have!**
- **This will be the card you design**

STEP 2:

- **Now that you have your card, we are going to brainstorm ideas and do some research BEFORE we begin designing**
- **In your DO NOW portfolio, create a new slide by clicking on the **+** icon *under* File**
 - **At the top of the new page, title it **DO NOW; PLAYING ARTS PART 2****

STEP 2 CONT 'D

- **Answer the following questions on your **DO NOW; PLAYING ARTS PART 2** page:**

- 1. Which playing card are you re-designing?**
- 2. What was your first thought or idea that came to mind when you chose your card?**

(you can't say I don't know - really think about the card you chose and the cards we looked at in class)
