



## Playing Arts Project

Playing Arts is a worldwide project where designers and illustrators redesign ordinary playing cards.

For this project, you will choose a playing card at random and then complete DO NOW 3# *before* you begin designing your card.

The DO NOW #3 is to help you research and brainstorm ideas.

Are you inspired by today's pop culture? Design elements such as line and shape? Or are you inspired by the actual card you chose?

You may use Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, or a combination of the two programs.

Your design should be on a 8.5 " X 11" document

Your playing card design is totally up to you. This is your chance to show your creativeness, your ideas, and expressions!

However, you will be required to show the following in your creation:

- ~ Balance: either symmetrical or asymmetrical
- ~ The number or letter of your card as well as the symbol must be visible
  - Your symbol may be altered/changed to fit your design but it is not required to alter it!
- ~ Any image that you take from Google or any online source, ***MUST*** be altered/changed in some way due to CopyRight laws
- ~ You must use a ***minimum*** of 2 tools already learned from this year (pen tool, stroke, fill, stroke styles, quick selection tools, etc.)
