
ROY LICHTENSTEIN

For our next project, we will be learning about Roy Lichtenstein and the Pop Art movement. Roy Lichtenstein used lines, dots, black outlines, and primary colors to create a comic book look in his paintings. The dots that he used were called **BENDAY DOTS**, mimicking the styles of printers.

When you are doing this sketchbook assignment, choose your image wisely - you could use the design in your main project!

- 1. FIND A ROY LICHTENSTEIN artwork on GOOGLE and sketch it out in your sketchbook using the ENTIRE page
 - a. Once you have it drawn out entirely, use <u>colored pencils</u> (on the front table) to fill in your design using <u>at least 3 designs</u> and <u>3 of the colors</u> shown below
 - i. If you would prefer your line drawings and designs to be outlined in SHARPIE, you can, but it is your choice for this assignment
 - b. The <u>entire page should be drawn neatly</u>, and <u>colored in entirely to</u> resemble an artwork from a comic book.
 - i. This assignment will be worth **50 points**
