# SKETCHBOOK ASSIGNMENT: BALANCE



### **MATERIALS NEEDED:**

• Sketchbook • Pencil / Eraser • Sharpie Markers (Ultra Fine and Fine)

For this sketchbook assignment, you will be creating a series of thumbnail sketches showing different designs needed for our next project. The designs can be **abstract**, or non-representational,

Or, the designs can be **realistic**, or represents an ordinary object.

Every design that you use, **MUST** show **positive** and **negative** space.

If you do not remember learning about positive and negative space, please go back and view <u>Sketchbook assignment #5</u>

If you look at the photos above, you will notice a colored background and white, cut-out cover sheet. The designs that you create in this sketchbook assignment may be used for your white, cut-out cover sheet.

You will be creating 4 sets of 10 thumbnail sketches, each set showing one of the forms of balance;

symmetry, radial, and approximate



Remember, while you are coming up with your cover designs, you can use **ABSTRACT** or **REALISTIC** designs, as long as they show **POSITIVE** and **NEGATIVE** space

## **GRADING**

You will need a total of 40 designs = 40 points

(10 for each type of balance)

Each design will be worth 1 point

They ALL need to show positive and negative space by shading in the negative space

If they do not show positive or negative space, you will be deducted **.5** points for each design missing this part

Timeliness & Neatness = 10 points

Sketchbook assignment completed on time = 5 points

Thumbnail layout is correct and designs are created neatly (craftsmanship)
